I kindly inform you that the funds unused under Competition No. 1 of Internal Projects – discipline: MEDICAL SCIENCES, have been distributed.

According to the proposal of the Council for the Medical Sciences Discipline and the decision of HM Rector, the unused funds have been divided into units the employees of which are conducting research in medical sciences.

The basis for the division is the sum of points obtained by the employees of a given unit for the accomplishments in 2019 – publications, projects and patents – qualified as accomplishment in medical sciences. For employees declaring activity in two discipilines, publications were qualified for the disciplines indicated in the declarations generated in the WUM.PUBLIKACJE system; the projects and patents were qualified to the leading disciplines. The summary was made according to the status as at the date of the summary of accomplishments for 2019, i.e. for 15 May this year.

The increase in the funding for units in 2020 was defined according to the formula below.
