Dear Sirs/Madams,

I kindly inform you that in agreement with the University's Scientific Council, there were developed new principles of the publication fund's functioning to be valid in 2022.

**The principles of publication fund activity binding from 1 January 2022.**

1. Co-financing may be dedicated to covering the costs of publication or costs of linguistic preparation (proofreading).
2. MUW employees without PhD degree, regardless of their position, as well as students in doctoral studies, MUW doctoral students and students may obtain a 100% co-funding for the costs of one publication in a journal with a score of at least 100 points, if they are the first author of such work.
3. MUW employees qualified for the N number at MUW may receive co-financing of one or more publications with a score value of 140 and more. The maximum amount of funding of one work (jointly the publication costs and proofreading) is PLN 5,000.
4. Call for applications is held on a continuous basis.

Additionally, all works with a score of at least 100 points, by authors qualified for the N number at MUW, which were accepted for printing in the period **1 January 2022-15 February 2022** may receive partial co-funding, depending on the work score and available funds. Relevant applications should be submitted by 15 February 2021.
